I voluntarily agree, therefore, to assume all risks and responsibility for any such injury or accident, which might occur to me or my child during any of Eden Dance Academy Pty Ltd classes, rehearsals, performances, or activities. I also exempt, release, and indemnify Eden Dance Academy Pty Ltd, its owners, agents, volunteers, assistants, employees, guest artists, faculty members, and/or students from all liability claims, demands, or causes of action whatsoever from any damage, loss, injury, or death to me, my children, or property which may arise out of or in connection with participation in any classes or activities conducted by Eden Dance Academy Pty Ltd. I further hereby voluntarily agree to waive my rights and that of my heirs and assigns to hold Eden Dance Academy Pty Ltd, its owners, agents, employees, guest artists, faculty members, and/or students liable for such damage, loss, injury, or death. I understand that I should be aware of my physical limitations and agree not to exceed them. If I am signing this waiver for my children, I certify that I am the parent or legal guardian and have the right to waive these rights.

You understand and accept that enrolment in dance, singing or acrobatics classes and workshops at Eden Dance Academy Pty Ltd is a service and incurs a fee and late fees apply for invoices not paid by the due date. You have provided the correct details for invoicing and fees will be paid by the due date or a payment schedule will be established.

Code of Conduct

Just a few sensible guidelines in the interest of safety, to help keep things calm and orderly at the studio and make sure that students can get the most out of their classes without any disruption:

- No smoking anywhere on the premises, including in our car park.
- Younger siblings must be supervised (and always stay quiet) so as not to disrupt the lessons or the other parents waiting.
- No running through the corridors.
- Students should not enter a classroom without the teacher
- Disruptive behavior is unacceptable, and students will be removed from class after two warnings. This includes talking out of turn in class.
- No food or drink in the dance rooms accept water.
- All students are expected to be kind, friendly and respectful of one another both in and out of the studio. We're here to support each other and work as a team.
- Bullying or highly competitive unsportsmanlike behaviour is not welcome and in conflict with our Child Safety Policy. All such matters will be managed by the Director.

We reserve the right to suspend or cancel an enrolment if a student's behaviour is continually disruptive to the learning environment and/or distracting to fellow students. It is important for us to be able to do this, not as punishment (we're not here to play disciplinarian to your children) but simply to ensure that the students at EDA can have the best possible experience.

Help us keep our studio tidy...

Please respect our studios and help us to keep it looking nice. Keep your feet off the furniture and hands off the walls and mirrors. Take all rubbish with you or place it in one of the many bins provided. Drink spillages and "accidents" are parents' responsibility to clean up immediately, please ask at reception for a mop or sponge if required.

There is a class happening...

Parents and students and students' sibling are asked to keep all noise to a minimum when in the foyer or waiting in between classes. Sometimes noise filters through to the class and becomes a distraction preventing the students from and optimal learning experience.
